the writer and the illustrator receive individual advances, and split all royalties 50/50. It ' s the fairest way to split the proceedings. The publisher takes care of all that for you and sends you a royalty statement twice a year. If you ' re self-publishing, you need to negotiate payment with the illustrator.

FAQ: How do I find an illustrator for my book? – James Foley

A traditional publisher will choose an illustrator whose work and style best complement your text. As the writer, you generally have no power over this decision or what goes in the illustrations, nor will you have contact with the illustrator during the process. Just trust and hang on. Most authors are thrilled with the final product.
